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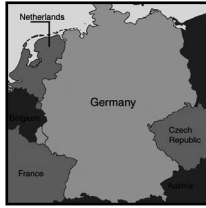

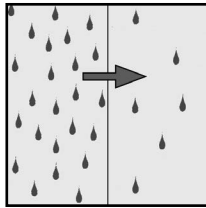

Few means not many or almost none.

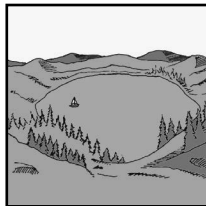

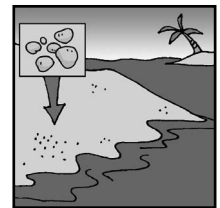
Pickup trucks are small, open trucks that people use to move light loads from one place to another.

sand²⁰

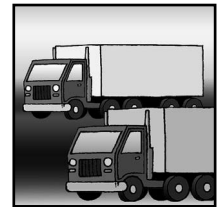
Sand is little pieces of rocks that can be found in deserts and next to lakes and oceans.

Semi trucks are big trucks with two parts. The front part has an engine, and the back part holds a load.

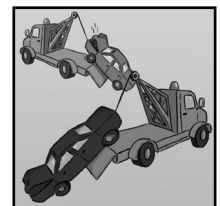
Semi trucks move things like mail, food, and gas from one place to another.

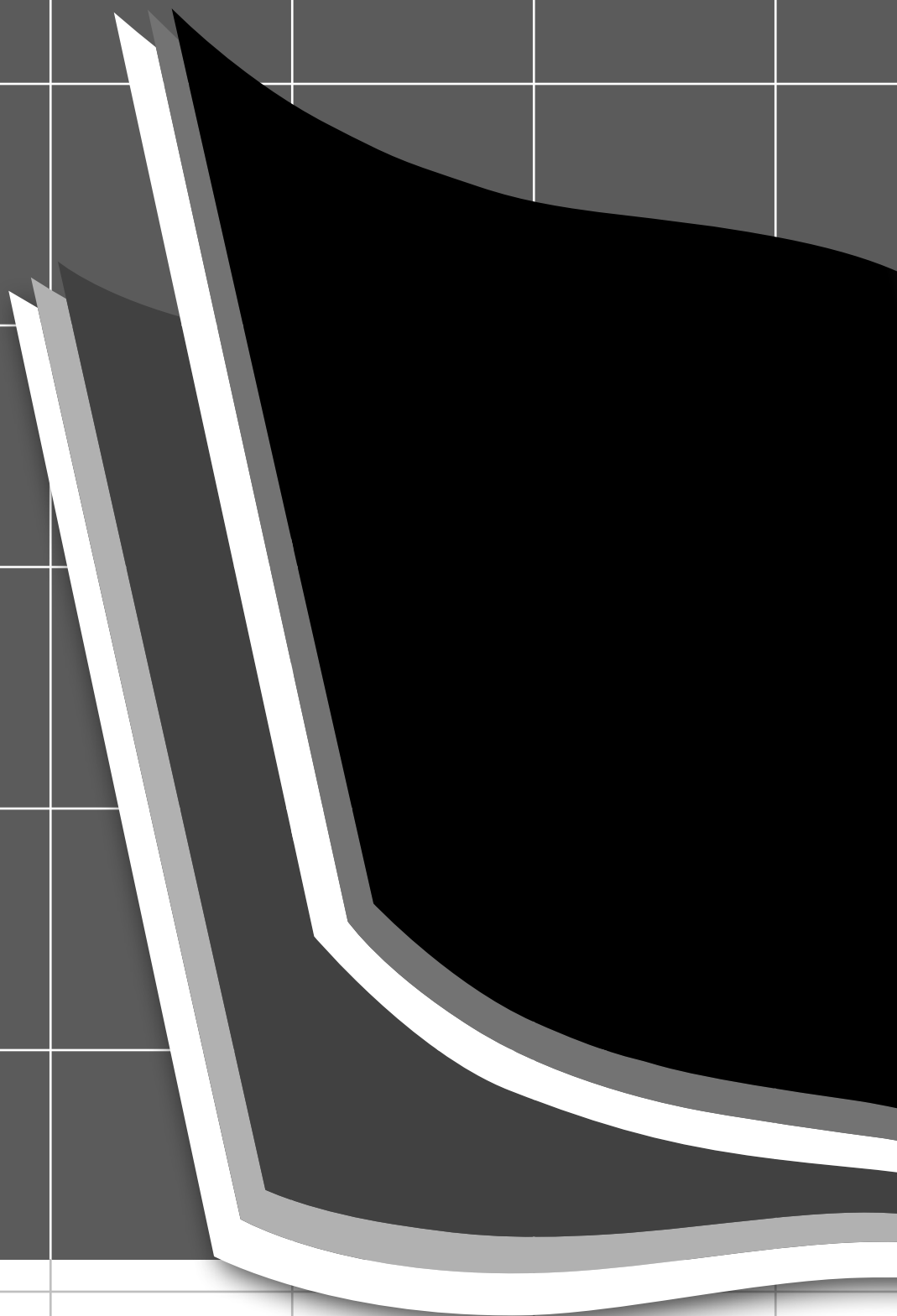


tow trucks²²
